Developing Your Child



➔ Large and Fine Motor Development

- Providing opportunities to enhance motor development
Eg. climbing stairs, hopping into a hula hoop, balancing on a low beam, threading beads, fixing puzzles, building block towers, drawing shapes, beginning to form picture symbols, pouring liquid with minimum spills, ...etc...
- Fostering grasps of holding crayons and markers with fingers instead of fists.
- Undresses and dresses with minimum assistance

➔ Language and Communication Development

- Increase in vocabulary, make up words to fit needs
- Use simple sentences to express needs
- Familiarise songs and rhyme that have many repetitions and use finger play
- Exercise curiosity by asking questions; why, what, where, what...
- Tells events of a simple story
- Recognition of one's name
- Recognition of Alphabet Aa to Ee with picture aid
- Names objects

1 to 5



➔ Math

- Recognition of numbers 1 to 5
- Recognition of shapes and colours
- Sorting and Classifying
- Comparing (big/small, tall/short)

➔ Social and Emotional Development

- Engages in play with peers
- Plays with others and responds positively
- Acts more cooperatively
- Follows simple requests; plays within the given area/toys
- Expresses feelings

➔ Visual and Performing Arts

- Free expression through drawing and scribbling
- Tearing and Pasting
- Printing and painting
- Singing nursery rhymes and poems
- Dramatising songs and doing finger play
